

Silver Birch

A warm welcome back to Silver Birch class! It has been so lovely to see you all and start to get to know you. In English, this term excited to start our unit on dystopian worlds: reading texts and then writing our own story! In Science, we are exploring Light, with lots of experiments to investigate this fascinating subject. In Maths, we are working on percentages, place value and securing our number work. In History, we are really excited to start our work on the Romans and in Geography we are comparing Italy and the UK and learning about our local geography. We are learning Spanish as our language this year too.

Key Stage 4- Lemon & Lime

We are very excited to be in our new classrooms, and we have our own Key Stage 4 common rooms and toilets! Students will have more independence and autonomy, as befitting their new Key Stage 4 status.

However, with great power comes great responsibility and it's exciting that we are beginning to study for qualifications. This half term, in English we are studying advertising with a focus on reading, as part of our Functional Skills Course. In Maths, we are learning basic number skills, another Functional Skills course. In Science, we are learning about the human body, focusing on cells, tissues, organs and systems, and this is an AQA Entry Level course. Students will also improve their physical health in PE (we have walking for those who are less sports-inclined!). Our ASDAN option courses are in either Expressive Arts (explore) or FoodWise (healthy eating and practical cooking skills) and there is the optional PE course too. The other ASDAN short courses are IT, history (the history of Ruddington), PSD, PSHE and Beliefs and Values. Enrichment replaces Golden Time to allow our students to gain relevance and enjoyable skills, such as running their own enterprise to raise money to buy more equipment for their common room.

Lemon

I am really excited about the wonderful young people in Lemon Class, with all their potential, talents, individuality and general loveliness. We have our pet corner set up (we're going to buy crickets and fish to add to it!) and everything is raring to go! Our lemon tree has grown loads over the summer, just as we will, in our next and exciting stage of life at Easthorpe School.

Hello to the new Lime Class! We are all really excited to get stuck into the amazing things we have on offer in Key Stage 4 this year. School uniform/PE kit/Forest School kit

If you need to purchase any uniform, then please come to the school office who can help you with this. You are more than welcome to look at uniform and/or try it on before purchasing anything. Payments for uniform can be made in cash or via a bank transfer. School uniform consists of a white polo shirt, blue sweatshirt or cardigan and black/grey trousers/skirts. Our PE t-shirt is royal blue and can be worn with shorts/jogging bottoms depending on the season. Please speak to class teachers for confirmation of PE days.

We are flexible with regard to our uniform as we want to ensure that all of our pupils are comfortable and happy in what they are wearing during their time at Easthorpe.

For PE lessons, please can you make sure that your child has a royal blue PE t-shirt, appropriate bottoms & suitable footwear in school at all times. PE t-shirts are available from the school office.

As we are now offering all pupils Forest School, which will take place on Thursdays, they will need to have suitable clothes to wear in all weather conditions (e.g. waterproof shoes) and these will need to stay in school.



























Please ensure that, as the weather gets colder, pupils come to school in appropriate continuous footwear.

School dinners

School dinners are provided for our pupils free of charge should they not wish to bring a packed lunch. These are provided by Nottingham City Catering and are delivered to school. We will send links via email to complete your child's dinner choices should they wish to have a school meal.
